- Declaration of Restrictions
- ➤ Articles of Incorporation
- > Bylaws
- ➤ Plat Map
- ➤ Board Resolutions, Policies, and Rules and Regulations

Declaration of Restrictions

- > Establishes the planned community
 - > Identifies the lots or units
 - ➤ Creates use restrictions
 - ➤ Designates responsibility for maintenance
 - >Sets architectural controls
 - > Establishes voting rights
 - ➤ Institutes assessments

Plat Map

Shows the lots and any common areas on a map

Articles of Incorporation

➤ Incorporates Association as a nonprofit corporation

Bylaws

- > Bylaws establish Association governance
 - ➤ Designate Board of Directors Number and Qualifications
 - ➤ Identify Officers and Duties
 - ➤ Require annual and board meetings
 - > Establish quorum requirements

Rules and Regulations

- Established by the Board of Directors as a "policy resolution" (unless owner vote required)
- Consistent with the Declaration and Bylaws

Governing Laws

> Federal Law

- > Fair Housing Act (as amended) 42 U.S.C. 3601-3619 (prohibits discrimination in housing)
- > Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 42 U.S.C. 12101 (prohibits discrimination to persons with disabilities in places of public accommodation)
- > Freedom to Display the American Flag Act of 2005, Pub.L.No. 109-243, 120 Stat. 572 (2006)
- ➤ United States Bankruptcy Code 11 U.S.C. 101, et seq.
- Regulations
 - > Over-the-Air Reception Devices Rule 47 C.F.R. 1.400
- Oregon Planned Community Act ORS 94.550 et seq.
 - > Because the Homes Association was created before 2002 only limited provisions apply to the extent those provisions are *consistent* with the Declaration and Bylaws.
- ➤ Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Act ORS Chapter 65
 - > Applies to the Homes Association to the extent *consistent* with the Bylaws.
- ➤ Washington County Ordinances
 - > Zoning, parking, noise, etc.

Hierarchy Pt. II

- ➤ORS 94.770(2) (which applies to the Homes Association because not inconsistent with the governing documents) provides:
 - ➤ In the event of a conflict between the declaration and the bylaws of a planned community or between the declaration and the articles of incorporation, the declaration shall prevail except as otherwise provided in the Act.
